### Saskatoon Curbside Recycling And Lawson Heights School – Working Together for Our Environment

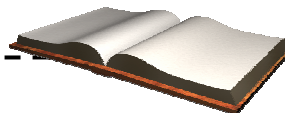
Saskatoon Curbside Recycling (SCR) is a residential recycling program initiated in 2003 by five residents of Saskatoon. SCR would like to provide your family with two blue bins, two strong plastic bags and pickup from your curbside every two weeks, **all paper products, beverage containers, tin, glass, and plastic.** The cost is \$13/month + GST for families with students (proof of enrolment needed). Complete the attached form and submit to the school office.

**All library books are due back to the LRC on June 8.**



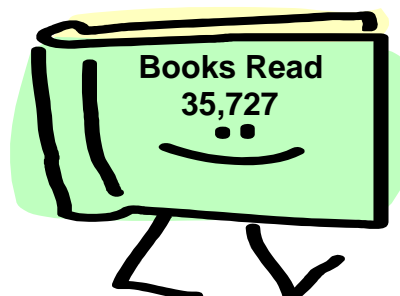

### Band Camp

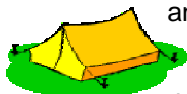

#### Registering for the Bridge City Boogie

- Go to [www.bridgecitybookie.ca](http://www.bridgecitybookie.ca) & click on box **“register Online/go”**
- This now opens up to active.com page – then click on green box **“Register Now”**
- Select your category which will be either a student or adult – Team in 2KM, 5KM or 10KM
- Check waiver agreement box, 18 or older box and enter birth date of person being registered - \*note: if member is a student, a parent must type their name in the signature box. If person registering is 18 years or older, just type in your own name in the signature box.
- Click **“agree and continue”**
- This brings you to the Registration page, Select Lawson Heights School team from the drop box. Next fill out all information this is **red\***
- Click **“continue”**
- If you are done, just follow payment options. **IF** you would like to register another person, click the shopping cart icon that says **“view cart”** on the top right of the screen. It will show you that you have registered someone and your current \$total. Click the green box **“Register Someone Else”** and repeat all the previous steps.
